EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAMS

An early childhood program is essential for social development while exploring early learning concepts. Classroom lessons focus on social growth, cognitive development, emergent literacy and motor development. Environmental awareness is one focus of our early childhood program. One morning each week is held outdoors at the Izaak Walton League Conservancy with the goal of having students acquire an early love for nature.

Options include a two, three or five half-day schedule from 8-11 a.m. or a two, three or five full-day schedule from 8 a.m.-3 p.m. Parents can select the days of the week that work best for their family. In addition, there is a before- and after-school program available for an additional fee, if needed.
