MARCH SPECIALS were a great success

We highlighted our gas scrip cards and generated over \$1,500 in scrip rebates just on gas card purchases in the month of March! Thank you for your support.

Please continue to use scrip for your gas purchases. Shell Local earns 10% and can be used in Wisconsin and the UP. KwikTrip Local now earns 5% and KwikTrip Reloadable cards earn 4%.

CHALLENGE FOR APRIL

For the month of April we are highlighting grocery purchases. Although the rebate %'s are typically lower for grocery stores, most of us spend more at the grocery store. Small amounts add up fast. If you spend \$150 per week, you could generate between \$20-30 in scrip rebates in just one month and \$240 or more in a year. Are you up for the challenge? We hope so.

Pick N Save, Festival, Woodmans, Walmart and Target are available as Quickscrip. Piggly Wiggly and Meijer are available as Special Order scrip.

Pick N Save, Meijer, Walmart and Target offer **reloadable** cards for your convenience. Purchase a scrip card, register the card in your shopwithscrip account and add funds whenever you need. For grocery stores that don't offer scrip but accept VISA gift cards (Costco, Aldi), you can earn 1.25% on your VISA gift card scrip purchases.

TRACKING YOUR SCRIP REBATES AND ORDER HISTORY

The shopwithscrip website provides reports to help you track your scrip rebates and order history. See the video [Tracking your scrip rebates and order history](#) or follow the instructions below.

1. Log in to your shopwithscrip account
2. Go to Dashboard at bottom and click on “Order History”
3. Our program year runs from June 1 to May 31. Rebates are distributed twice per year in January and June. Under “Rebate Distributed” you will see how your earnings have been distributed in the current program year.
4. As a school family, your order history would look similar to this. (Report shows amounts before the end of the year. The account activity report resets after the end of the program year.)

Under the “**rebate distributed**”, you will see that ½ of the distribution was a tuition credit for the school family of \$214.58 and the other ½ was distributed to St. Bernard school as a credit toward the family’s 3rd source funding requirement

The “**Rebates Not Yet Distributed**” of \$99.75 represents the gross rebates earned since the last distribution before the sharing and administrative fees have been applied.

For this family, they could determine their expected distribution for “rebates not yet distributed” as: Tuition Credit of \$39.90 (40% of \$99.75); 3rd source funding requirement \$39.90 (40% of \$99.75)

5. Sometimes grandparents or others designate their earnings for a school family. In our example: **Gladys and Jack Jackson designated their earnings totaling \$62.52 for George and Mary Washer, the school family. In addition, Gloria Dryer contributed her rebate earnings of \$3.94 to the Washer family. George and Mary Washer's Order History would look like this.**

Gladys and Jack Jackson's order history would show the \$62.52 as a contribution to the George and Mary Washer family.

The **rebate not yet distributed** amounts show the gross rebate earnings since the last distribution period. The Washer's report would show only the earnings of the Washers. The Jackson's report would show only their earnings since the last distribution. To determine the distributions that the Washer family can expect, they would have to get the earnings information from the Jacksons and Gloria Dryer.

OTHER REPORTS AVAILABLE

For summary reports go to your Dashboard, Order history at the bottom and then select Reports at the left.

SCRIP GIFT CERTIFICATE OPTION RETURNING IN MAY

We will again be offering scrip gift certificates for purchase in May and June. The gift certificate option replaces the teacher/staff appreciation scrip program of previous years. As an extra bonus, the gift certificates can be given to anyone. It is a great way to say thank you, congratulations or just “have a good day” to those special people in your life.

How does the certificate program work?

The certificates come in three denominations \$3, \$5 or \$10.

You order the gift certificates just as you would order any special order scrip gift card. You will submit your order and payment using the normal scrip process. You can order online or drop off your order (watch for order form with the May newsletter) at the parish office or in the collection basket at church. You will pick up your order from the parish office. You can then complete the “to” and “from” information on the certificate and give it to your gift recipient.

How To Order There are several options:

1. Online order and payment at ShopwithScrip.com (preferred method)
2. Order using the RaiseRight mobile app (preferred method)
2. Mail in paper order and check – NOTE: NO PAPER ORDERS OR CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED AT SCHOOL
