This will serve as an Advent service project. Each grade was updated with <u>Christ Our Life New Evangelization</u> series. Due to lack of interest and involvement, marketing meeting will now become a portion of SAC meeting.</li> <li>● Experience, middle level students will be combining with other GRACE schools and will participate in speakers and field trips together to enhance their experiences. 7th and 8th will join SJB students and attend Camp Tekakwitha in Nov. Outdoor learning space budget is approx \$6000. Plans are drawn, permits submitted with hopes to begin construction in October.</li> </ul>
